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DIMINISHING BAND FELL INTO MAYHEM. WHEN RESCUE ARRIVED THIRTEEN DAYS LATER, ONLY FIFTEEN WERE ALIVE. AMONG THE HANDFUL OF SURVIVORS WERE TWO MEN WHOSE BESTSELLING ACCOUNT OF THE MARITIME DISASTER SCANDALIZED EUROPE AND INSPIRED PROMISING ARTIST THÉODORE GÉRICHAULT, WHO THREW HIMSELF INTO A STUDY OF THE MEDUSA TRAGEDY, TURNING IT INTO A VAST CANVAS IN HIS PAINTING, THE RAFT OF THE MEDUSA.
